

COLOMBO / TUTICORIN PASSENGER SERVICE

Sea passenger transportation between India & Sri Lanka is being established consequent to the joint declaration issued in 2010, following talks held between H.E. the President of Sri Lanka Hon. Mahinda Rajapakse and Prime Minister of India Hon. Manmohan Singh. Government owned national carrier of both countries, Shipping Corporation of India (SCI) and Ceylon Shipping Corporation Ltd (CSCL) will be the exclusive operators nominated to operate this service.

DISTANCE & DURATION

The distance between Colombo and Tuticorin is about 152 nautical miles equal to 228 miles and the duration of the journey is about 10 to 12 hours.

ABOUT THE SERVICE

CSCL is the General Sales Agent (GSA) for Colombo / Tuticorin passenger ferry service operated by M/S Flemingo Liner who has been nominated to operate this service by SCI.

The vessel M/V Scotia Prince has been deployed to operate this passenger ferry service between Tuticorin & Colombo. The vessel is sailing 2 round trips per week initially. During the next phase, it is expected to make it a 3 round trips per a week.

The Scotia Prince is a comfortable, spacious passenger ferry vessel with facilities on board equalling cruise lines. She can carry up to 1044 passengers. There are 09 levels around the Scotia Prince which contains both inward and outward facing cabins and other facilities like restaurants, bars, lounge areas, etc... for the benefit and convenience of passengers. There are options of Economy, Deluxe, Super Deluxe, First & special Cabins for physically challenged.
